*Call to register for a class well in advance of the date listed and send a release form and check for the class fee, made payable to ISD #2142, Community Education. Classes will be cancelled 1-2 days before the scheduled start if Bobbi does not know if anyone or enough people are interested in signing up. Supply fees must be paid directly to instructors the first night of class.*

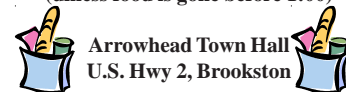
